DAY 2: BIRMINGHAM, AL

- Visit The 16th Street Baptist Church, the site of the KKK bombing that shook the nation
- Drive to Montgomery and visit The Legacy Museum and The Lynching Memorial
- Dinner at a local beer garden



DAY 4: NEW ORLEANS, LA

- Downtime (Breakfast and Lunch on Own)
- Afternoon tour of the Laura Plantation, followed by a facilitated discussion of slavery and its impact
- This evening, enjoy a group dinner in New Orleans



DAY 6: MEMPHIS, TN

- Visit the Lorraine Motel Civil Rights Museum, the location of MLK Jr.'s assassination
- Facilitated discussion to close out trip
- Farewell dinner in Memphis



DAY 1: BIRMINGHAM, AL

- Fly to Birmingham, AL and check into hotel
- Private evening tour of Bham with local guide
- Trip introduction and welcome dinner on rooftop



DAY 3: MONTGOMERY, AL

- Visit the Southern Poverty Law Center, co-founded and initially led by late UVA professor and renowned civil rights activist Julian Bond
- Drive to Selma and visit the National Voting Rights Museum
- Then, march across the famed Edmund Pettus Bridge with an ex foot-soldier
- Drive to New Orleans (Dinner on Own)



DAY 5: SUMNER, MS

- Prepare for an early departure for Greenwood, MS for lunch. Afterwards, take a short drive to Money, MS, where you will encounter sites associated with the lynching of Emmett Till
- Head to Sumner, MS for a discussion at the Tallahatchie Courthouse, where the Emmett Till's murder trial took place
- Drive to Memphis (Dinner on Own)



DAY 7: MEMPHIS, TN

- (Lunch on Own)
- Departure for homecity
